



Wooden packaging requirements:

1. Wooden packaging waste generated in Lithuania consumed for own use, waste code 15 01 03. The term "Consumption of packaging for own use" is understood as the term is defined in the Republic of Lithuania Law on Packaging and Packaging Waste, i.e. and packaging of goods imported in the territory of the Republic of Lithuania or packaged goods produced in the territory of the Republic of Lithuania in order to use these products in own activities for transferring them to another person.
2. Wood packaging must be clean, it cannot be impregnated, painted, lacquered, smeared with chemicals, lubricants.
3. Wooden packaging may not contain large metal impurities. Nails and staples are allowed.
4. The minimum accepted quantity of wooden packaging – 0.5 tons.

Payment for wooden packaging:

1. Grigeo Baltwood UAB is included in the list of waste processors entitled to issue the documents confirming the clean-up of waste product and (or) packaging.
2. Wooden packages are accepted free of charge, by issuing the documents confirming the clean-up of waste.
